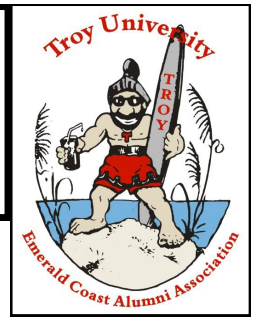

President's Line



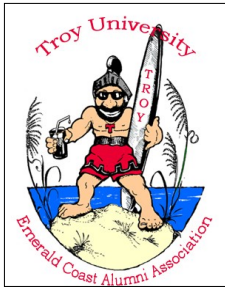
Hello fellow alumni and friends of the Emerald Coast Chapter,

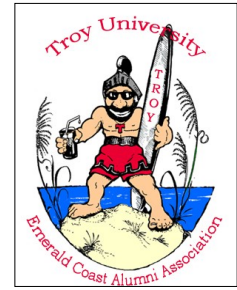

Need an E-mail for Life

There is an e-mail account program available for Troy University Alumni.

You must have graduated from one of Troy's campuses.

You must have an existing server and e-mail account to participate.

Go to your internet explorer or internet page – type in Troy.edu. That will take you to the Troy University Home Page.

Click on Alumni and Friends in the column on the left.

That takes you to the Alumni page. About 2 paragraphs down you will see the invitation to register and a short explanation.

Click on the To register link. That takes you to the window to register. They check to see when you graduated. It takes about 5 days to become effective. They will notify you when you can start using it.

It will look like –
yourname@alumni.troy.edu

It is really just a forwarding e-mail program/service, but you basically just have to remember someone's name.

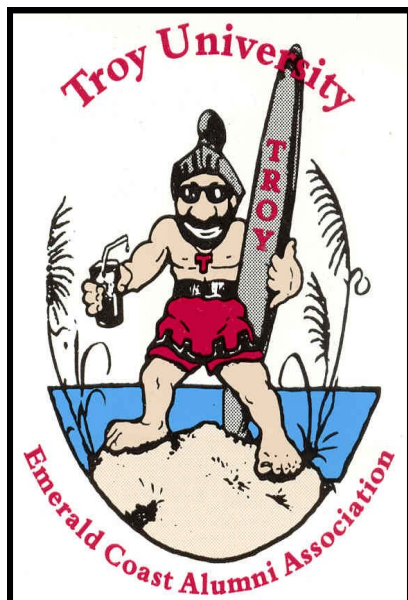
